Application Help

Application Basics

Inyo County Parcel Information System 3.0 reflects a complete redesign, with the intention of making the application easier to use and improve its performance. The search functionality has been streamlined allowing users to search for any parcel through focused searches that target individual fields.

As opposed to the prior version of the Parcel Information System, this application does not provide users with the ability to perform more complex analyses (such as buffers or advanced selection), or toggle layers on and off. It is designed around the most common use of the application – searching for parcels and getting information.

General Navigation

All navigation now takes place through direct interaction with the map – there is no longer specific tools for Pan or Zoom.

- **Zooming:**
 - Double click on the map to zoom in
 - Use zoom slider bar on the top left of the map to zoom in and out
 - Use the mouse wheel to zoom in and out
- **Panning:**
 - Left click and drag around the screen to pan the extent



Search Function

Searches are performed across all parcels when you click the Find button. If you know specifically what information you are looking for in the data it is best to constrain your search by selecting the radio button that corresponds to the type of data you are looking for. The Search All option looks at all fields in the database.


1. Click the desired search type bubble
2. Press 'Find' button
3. Click on the desired result in table
(table can be sorted by clicking on the headers)
4. After map has zoomed to the area of interest, click on the highlighted parcel for more information

Getting Parcel & Unit Information

Parcel information is returned in callout/bubbles based on the location of the mouse click (*the bubbles will always draw to the right of the cursor click location*). A parcel that has been selected through a search will be returned in a blue color, whereas parcels that have been inquired upon directly on the map are returned in a yellow color.

Getting Parcel Information

1. Navigate to desired area on the map
2. Left-click on parcel/unit you want information for (*Selected parcel will highlight & info window be displayed*)
3. If multiple features are selected, a (1 of x) will appear on the top left of the header. Toggle between them with arrows at top right side of the header.
