MONUMENT DESCRIPTIONS:

902015 FOUND A 2 INCH IRON PIPE WITH A 1 3/8 INCH BRASS CAP STAMPED "VV.2 IN.1 MS. 6766" (FOR VALLEY VIEW MILLSITE CORNER No. 2, INSPIRATION MILLSITE CORNER No. 1, MINERAL SURVEY No. 6766), 10 INCHES ABOVE THE TOP OF A MOUND OF STONES, 2.5 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 10 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. MONUMENT WAS FOUND IN GREAT CONDITION, STRAIGHT AND SOLID, LEFT AS IS AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 1.5 FEET EASTERLY. FOUND 1966 BEARING TREES:

MONUMENT WAS FOUND IN POOR CONDITION, LEANING DOWNHILL. RE-PLUMBED MONUMENT AND BUILT A MOUND OF STONES, 3.5 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 18 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 1.5 FEET NORTHERLY. MONUMENT WAS FOUND IN FAIR CONDITION, LEANING SLIGHTLY TO THE NORTH. RE-PLUMBED MONUMENT AND REBUILT MOUND OF STONES TO 2.5 FEET IN DIAMETER AND 10 INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND. SET A U CHANNEL ALUMINUM POST WITH A FOREST SERVICE 54-9 MONUMENT SIGN AND A FOREST SERVICE 54-2 BOUNDARY SIGN, 1.3 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY. FOUND 1966 BEARING TREES:
